The Blue Reef wine range is a newly released product range committed to helping the ZooX Fund™, an organisation specifically dedicated to funding research into the effects of climate change on the Great Barrier Reef.

HARVEST NOTES

The conditions in 2007 were extremely dry with vintage starting two weeks earlier than expected and finishing a month earlier than usual, this being the quickest vintage in our history. As a result, yields were down approximately 30% in our Central Victorian vineyards but the quality was of an extremely high standard. Due to the lack of water, berries were smaller and bunch weights were lower but this has seen an increase in colour and flavour intensity across the board. This season was definitely about quality rather than quantity.

WINE DESCRIPTION

A powerhouse of a wine, bursting with ripe fruit flavours such as spicy dark plums, blackberries, black olives and mint. A tight palate structure reveals more of the same, but with the addition of some lovely, cedary oak and some fine, dusty tannins, resulting in a medium weight, well-balanced wine.
